



Guidelines for authors

Regular oral presentations (*)

- Length: 17 minutes talk + 3 minutes for a short round of questions. At the end of each session there will be a 15 to 30 minutes discussion slot where more questions can be asked to the speakers of the session
- Bring your presentation on a memory stick and upload it onsite, at the latest before the morning session of the day when your talk is scheduled. Members of the organizing committee will be on-site to help you.
- All presentations must be prepared as Power Point or pdf slideshows. The lecture room has both a Windows and a Mac laptop available

Posters

- Please, print your poster in advance and bring it with you to the conference. There are no poster-printing facilities at Monte Verità
- Print your poster in a maximum A0 format (ca. 118x84 cm)
- Both portrait and landscape format are allowed and will fit the available boards
- Style, fonts, colors: no restrictions
- Posters can be displayed from Sunday evening to Thursday evening. Poster-viewing sessions are scheduled on Monday and Tuesday afternoon

Poster-pitches

All poster authors are invited to prepare a short introduction to their poster, which will be presented in plenary in the main lecture room before each poster viewing session (on Monday and Tuesday). The final assignment of each poster to either Session I or II will be communicated personally to each poster Author soon. For format, refer to the oral presentation guidelines above.

- Poster-pitches must not exceed 2 slides
- The total time slot for each pitch is 90 seconds
